## CIRCUIT Team Visits Pilot Site in Slovenia and Holds Third General Assembly in Ljubljana

**Ljubljana, April 25, 2024** — The CIRCUIT Project held its third general assembly in Ljubljana, over three days of intensive meetings and site visits from April 23-25, 2024.

Hosted by ZAG, the assembly featured opening remarks from FEHRL's Project Coordinator and INFRA PLAN's Technical Coordinators, providing a comprehensive overview of CIRCUIT's ongoing work. Key updates included advancements in the CIRCUIT holistic framework, the Circularity Analytics Tool (CAT), and the development of a digital platform that integrates data from sources like Building Information Modelling (BIM) and Life Cycle Assessment (LCA). Day two highlighted progress in CIRCUIT's three pillars—recycling, reuse, and energy—and featured updates on Green Public Procurement (GPP) and Innovation Procurement (IP). Detailed presentations covered deployment strategies at the pilot sites and outlined a roadmap with key milestones for each work package.

The assembly concluded with a visit to ZAG's labs, where the team explored innovative uses of green materials, including clays in construction. The final day included a meeting with the Mayor of Črna na Koroškem, Romana Lesjak, and a site visit to a pilot bridge impacted by severe flooding in August 2023. CIRCUIT plans to enhance the bridge's resilience using Geosynthetic Reinforced Soil (GRS) abutments and repurposing debris as infill material.
